



Electric Department

Accomplishments:

1. Completed construction of new overhead electric line on Hancock Street.
2. Installed new 46kV breaker at Tupelo Primary Substation (464).
3. Refurbished and regasketed all power transformers at Tupelo Primary Substation.
4. Installed fiber optic loop for SCADA system (50% complete).
5. Upgraded 7 and installed 8 new Tornado Warning Sirens.
6. Installed LED traffic lighting (75% complete).
(Total of 85 traffic light intersections within the city – 64 intersections completed.)
7. Installed 2,500 feet of underground primary electric line on College View Drive for the new Health Sciences Building at ICC.
8. Identified and changed out fifty one (51) rotten utility poles.
9. Reconfigured (sequence and timing) of traffic lighting on Main Street for downtown lane changing project.
10. Relocated overhead electric lines between President Street and Fillmore Drive from back yards to right-of-way on Cleveland Street (partially underground).

Goals:

1. Complete Fiber Optic Loop.
 2. Upgrade of overhead primary electric lines on Garfield Street.
 3. Complete upgrade to LED traffic lighting.
 4. Relocate overhead electric lines on Lambard Drive and Jackson Street from back yards to the right-of-way on these streets.

Water and Sewer Department

Accomplishments:

1. Completed upgrade of Haven Acres sanitary sewer system to prevent cross connections of individual homeowners. (Community Development Block Grant – 50/50 match)
2. Water line upgrades:
 - Lakeview Drive (from 2” main to 6” main)
 - Rogers Drive (from 2” main to 6” main)
3. Sanitary sewer line upgrades:
 - Hwy 45 Outfall Sewer Line (Sunshine Mills) (from 10” main to 18” main)
 - Lakeshire Drive (upgraded to prevent infiltration)

Goals:

1. Upgrade of booster stations for more reliability and pumping capacity:
 - Priceville
 - Belden
 - Chesterville
2. Construction of new 500,000 gallon water tank in the Belden area.
3. Complete installation of water and sanitary sewer lines in annexed areas in a timely manner.
