Traffic Stop Leads to Felony Arrests

On 12-11-2022 at approximately 2:30 am TPD Officers were dispatched to the West Main Street area for a report of occupants in a white Nissan Altima throwing bottles and causing a disturbance. Officers located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop in the cross-town area. The initial investigation led to the discovery of marijuana, codeine syrup and fentanyl.

Agents of the North Mississippi Narcotics Unit arrested Ladarius Denman (20 y/o Male Verona) for Felony Possession of a Schedule V Controlled Substance; codeine and Aysia Harris (26 y/o Female Tupelo) for Felony Possession of Fentanyl.

On 12/11/2022, Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir set Denman's bond at \$15,000.

On 12/11/2022, Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir ordered Harris held without bond. At the time of this arrest Harris was free on felony bonds for two separate trafficking of fentanyl charges from April 2022 and July 2022.
