Burglary of a Vehicle Arrest Made:

On 08-04-23, at approximately 0315 hours, Officers with the Tupelo Police Department made contact with an individual on Dogwood Drive. The individual's vehicle was blocking the roadway and officers observed a nearby vehicle with the passenger door standing open. The individual exited the passenger side of the vehicle and was detained by officers. Officers were able to make contact with the owner of the vehicle and were informed that they did not know the individual that was in their vehicle.

After further investigation, Onterrio Cummings (24 y/o male, Tupelo) was taken into custody by the Tupelo Police Department and charged with Burglary of a Vehicle. Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir set Cummings bond at \$15,000. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
