Burglary of a Dwelling Arrest Made:

On 09-03-23, at approximately 1655 hours, Tupelo Police Department Officers responded to a call of a burglary on Mitchell Road. Upon arrival, officers contacted the property owner and were given a possible suspect vehicle description. A short time later, officers were able to perform a traffic stop on a possible suspect vehicle on Cliff Gookin Blvd. The driver was then taken into custody for multiple traffic violations.

After further investigation, Brandon Maldonado (23 y/o male, Corinth) was taken into custody by the Tupelo Police Department and charged with Burglary of a Dwelling. Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Allen set Maldonado's bond at \$20,000. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
