Armed Robbery Arrest Made:

On 09-23-2023, officers with the Tupelo Police Department responded to an Armed Robbery at a business on South Gloster Street. Employees on scene informed officers that a subject had used what appeared to be a firearm to rob the business of money and employee cellphones. Investigation led to a warrant for Armed Robbery being issued for Anthony E. Pierce (53 y/o male, Calhoun City)

On 12-23-2023 Pierce was arrested in Chicago, IL., for traffic violations and was detained for the warrant out of Tupelo, MS.

On 01-05-2024, after extradition back to Mississippi, Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir ordered Pierce to be held without bond. This case will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury. The Tupelo Police Department would like to thank Chicago PD for their assistance in this case.
